2. Turn right at W 3rd St - go 0.1 mi
3. Turn right at W St Clair Ave - go 0.1 mi
4. Turn right at Ontario St - go 0.7 mi
5. Bear right into the I-90 W entry ramp to (I-71) - 1.1 mi
6. Continue on I-71 S toward Columbus - go 17 mi
7. Take the OH-82 E exit 231A - go 0.3 mi
8. Bear right at Royalton Rd - go 0.7 mi
9. Turn left at Mill Hollow Ln - go 0.0 mi
10. Turn left at Cheerful Ln - go 0.2 mi

9. Take the I-71 exit 161/10 - go 0.4 mi
10. Bear right onto the I-71 S ramp - go 1.8 mi
11. Take the OH-82 E exit 231A - go 0.3 mi
12. Bear right at Royalton Rd - go 0.7 mi
13. Turn left at Mill Hollow Ln - go 0.0 mi
