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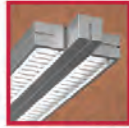
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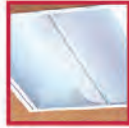

# Mill Stream Run Reservation: Driving Directions

## MILL STREAM RUN RESERVATION

### I-71 - FROM THE SOUTH (\*wayfinder sign)

- exit at Rt. 82 (Royalton Rd.)\*
- turn right (east) on Rt. 82
- Mill Stream Run Reservation entrance is 1 mile.
- For Albion Woods Reserved Picnic Area, turn left (north) on Valley Parkway; turn right on Albion Rd. off the parkway and continue 1/3 mile - entrance to Albion Woods will be on the left.
- For The Chalet, Bonnie Park Picnic Area and to connect with the Berea area of Mill Stream Run Reservation and Big Creek Reservation, turn left (north) on Valley Parkway.
- For Royalview Reserved Picnic Shelter, turn right (south) on Valley Parkway, then right on Royalview Lane and continue one mile to the end for the Royalview Picnic Area.
- To connect with Brecksville Reservation, turn right (south) on Valley Parkway and continue on the parkway as it curves and heads east.

### I-71 - FROM THE NORTH

- exit at Rt. 42 (Pearl Rd.)\*
- turn right (south) on Rt. 42
- continue 1.5 miles
- Mill Stream Run Reservation entrance is at the first traffic light past the Turnpike exit.
- For Albion Woods Reserved Picnic Area, Bonnie Park Picnic Area, The Chalet and Royalview Reserved Shelter, turn left (east) on Valley Parkway.
- For Albion Woods Reserved Picnic Area, at the first intersection, turn left on Albion Rd. Continue 1/3 mile, entrance to Albion Woods is on the left.
- For Royalview Reserved Shelter, stay on Valley Parkway, cross Rt. 82 and continue on the parkway. Turn right on Royalview Lane and continue one mile to the end of the road for the Royalview Picnic Area.
  - To connect with Big Creek Reservation, the Berea area of Mill Stream Run Reservation and Rocky River Reservation, turn right (west) on Valley Parkway.

### TURNPIKE - EXIT 161/Strongsville

- follow the exit ramp for Rt. 42
  - turn left (south) on Rt. 42 (Pearl Rd.)
    - Mill Stream Run Reservation entrance is at the first traffic light south of the Turnpike.
    - (see notes above in section I-71 from the north)
